Target audience

- Who are midway through their PhD and have a well-defined research plan (preferably approved by their institution).
- That work on a topic aligned with the conference theme and topics: ***"Technology Management for Intelligent, Open and Responsible Organizations and Ecosystems"***

Proposal guidelines

- Proposals should fit the IAMOT Conference 2025 Theme and Topics (iamot2025.com).
- **Proposals are not papers** and should clearly state the research problem, the methodological approach (planned or in execution), and the expected outputs and contributions to the field of study.
- Proposals should be written in English and developed in the provided template ([Link](#)).
- *Length:* from 6-8 pages - including mini bio, abstract and references.
- *File Format:* **PDF** - Ensure the file is named as follows: **PhD Name.pdf**

- Send the proposal to the email: iamot2025@usherbrooke.ca with the subject “PhD Colloquium Proposal”

Selection Criteria

- Relevance to the conference theme and topics
- Clarity and significance of the research problem and the objectives
- Theoretical depth and methodological rigor
- Originality and contribution to the field
- Clarity, coherence, and quality of writing
- Adherence to submission guidelines

- Decision notification – **April 28th**
- PhD Colloquium – **June 14-15th**
